






- Using "Browse For Folder" window locate and select the directory containing UC864 usb drivers as per point 1. then click "OK" and "Next".

9. In the warning window “Hardware installation” click “Continue Anyway”. Please note that the following screenshot is an related to the installation of one of the UC864 modules.

10. Click “Finish” to complete the installation of “Telit HSDAP USB Modem”.



11. The procedure “Found new hardware wizard” restarts to install the second port, “Telit Diagnostic Interface”. To install it repeat steps from 5 to 9. Then in the final windows click “Finish” to complete the installation.

12. The procedure “Found new hardware wizard” restarts to install the third port, “Telit Auxiliary Port”.
- To install it repeat steps from 5 to 9. Then in the final windows click “Finish” to complete the installation.




13. In case modem provides Nmea port, the procedure “Found new hardware wizard” restarts to install the third port, “Telit Nmea Port”.
- To install it repeat steps from 5 to 9. Then in the final windows click “Finish” to complete the installation.

At the end of the installation 3 ports are finally installed in the system:

- a) Telit HSDPA USB Modem
- b) Telit Auxiliary port
- c) Telit Diagnostic interface




In case modem provides Nmea port 4 ports are finally installed in the system:

- a) Telit HSDPA USB Modem
- b) Telit Auxiliary port
- c) Telit Diagnostic interface
- d) Telit Nmea Port



- Click on “Create a connection to the network at your workspace”



- Tick “Dial-up connection” checkbox , then click “Next”.

4.2 Connect using Dial-Up (USB mode)

To connect using the Dial-Up click twice on the icon in the desktop,



or click Start→Connect to→UC864 Terminal – HSDPA
